







Q10 Does your Club/Association have more or fewer teams / active members than three seasons ago, or has the number of teams / active members stayed about the same?





Q11 Does your Club/Association have plans to grow in the next three seasons?





Q12 How do you rate the quality of your Club's/Association's main playing facilities? (1 being very poor and 5 being very good)






