Andover & NW Hants

Current Stagecoach services revised as follows:

- 2 (Artists Way-Bus Station-River Way) Truncated to run Bus Station River Way only. Artists Way section transferred to revised 3.
- 3 (Bus Station-Harrow Way-Drove Estate-Charlton) Revised to run Bus Station Artists Way Goch Way Charlton, and withdrawn from Harrow Way and Charlton Road (transferred to new 4).
- 4 New route Bus Station Harrow Way Drove Estate, replacing southern part of current 3.
- 2, 3 and new 4 are all reduced to uneven headway, with alternating 35 and 40 minute gaps between journeys in the morning, and further reduced to 75 minutes in the afternoon (previously half-hourly throughout), to enable interworking of journeys on 3, 2 and 4 in rotation, and providing a cost saving, mainly during the afternoon when only one vehicle is required.
- 4/4A (Bus Station-Colenzo Drive-Admirals Way-Sheep Fayre) Existing circular route withdrawn (replaced by Wheelers Connect 10/10A for Admirals Way and Sheep Fayre only).
- 5 (Bus Station-Monxton-Grateley-Thruxton) Minor timetable revisions only.
- 7 (Andover-Newbury) Revised to run direct from Andover to Enham Alamein, and to include journeys numbered 7A between Burghclere and Newbury, replacing former 21/22. Section via Charlton Road and Saxon Fields transferred to new Wheelers Connect route 11.
- P20 (Bus Station-Picket Twenty) Withdrawn (replaced by Wheelers Connect 10)
- 21/22 (Newbury-Burghclere-Penwood) Withdrawn (part-replaced by new 7A)
- 23/24 (Newbury-Ecchinswell-Burghclere) Withdrawn (replacement awaits confirmation by Basingstoke & Deane Council)
- 68 (Stockbridge-Winchester) Two journeys in each direction retained by Stagecoach on schooldays only (Otherwise withdrawn and replaced by Wheelers Connect 16)
- 77 (Andover-Middle Wallop-Stockbridge Withdrawn (Floral Way to be covered by Wheelers Connect 14 & 15, Andover-Middle Wallop by 14, but no replacement for Middle Wallop-Stockbridge).
- 79 (Andover-Stockbridge-Broughton) Withdrawn (Wheelers Connect 12 will cover Andover-Picton Road/Winchester Road and 16 will cover Stockbridge-Houghton loop, but remainder awaits confirmation.

- 87 (Andover-Middle Wallop-Salisbury) Withdrawn (Limited replacement by Wheelers Connect 14)
- 626 (Andover-Sparsholt College) previously registered with 79 & 679, but continues unchanged.
- 677 (Admirals Way-Test Valley School) Details of replacement service by Clegg & Brooking to be confirmed.
- 679 (Monxton-Test Valley School) Details of replacement service by Clegg & Brooking to be confirmed.

New services to be provided by Wheelers Connect:

- 10/10A Bus Station-Sheep Fayre-Admirals Way, Mon-Sat, overall half-hourly with alternate journeys continue hourly to Picket Twenty (10) or Picket Piece (10A).
- 11 Bus Station–Rail Station-Hospital-Saxon Fields-East Anton-Tesco Superstore. Mon-Sat, hourly. Replaces part of 7 (Charlton Road/Saxon Fields), and provides new service to East Anton and Tesco.
- 12 Bus Station-Barlows Lane-Winchester Road-Hedge End Road-Bus Station. Mon-Sat, hourly. New mileage via Barlows Lane, and replaces parts of 79 (Picton Road & Winchester Road) and 4/4A (Hedge End Road).
- 13 Bus Station-Vigo Road-Colenzo Drive-Tesco. Mon-Sat, hourly. Replaces part of P20 (Vigo Road) and 4/4A (Colenzo Drive), with additional more direct facility to Tesco from Vigo Road.
- 14 Andover-Middle Wallop-Salisbury. Mon-Sat, two journeys from Andover and three from Salisbury. Limited replacement for Stagecoach 87, but running direct between Lopcombe Corner and Salisbury instead of via Winterslow and Pitton.
- 15 Andover-Chilbolton-Stockbridge. Mon-Sat, two journeys each way. Limited replacement for Stagecoach 79 (excluding Houghton loop, which is covered by 16), and supplementing 14 to serve Floral Way part of 77.
- 16 Houghton-Broughton-Stockbridge-Kings Somborne-Winchester. Mon-Sat, two journeys each way plus additional journeys between Stockbridge and Winchester on schooldays only. Limited replacement for 68 plus Houghton loop section of 79.
- W5 (Stockbridge-Kings Somborne-Romsey) Current Wheelers Connect service (which is a commercial operation) is withdrawn.
