NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Test Valley ("the Council") proposes to make a new Off Street Parking Places Order the effect of which is to amend The Borough Council of Test Valley Off Street Parking Places Order 2021 (the "2021 Order"). The general nature and effect of the amendments are as follows:

- 1. Clarification that vehicles loading or unloading within the Chantry Centre Service Yards need not be parked within marked parking bays, providing they are not causing any hazard or obstruction.
- 2. The fee for an Alma Road Zone Z Season Ticket permit has been increased to £50.
- 3. Clarification that Unity Minibuses when parking in Shepherds Spring Lane Car Park, Andover may if unavoidable, straddle parking bays.
- 4. The enabling Regulations referenced in the 2021 Order will be updated to reflect that the 2007 regulations will be superceded by new 2022 Regulations from 31st May 2022.
- 5. There is a boundary change to Car Park 61D on the Andover map.
- 6. All other provisions within the Order will remain unchanged.

The proposed new order will be known as The Borough Council of Test Valley Off Street Parking Places Order 2022.
