

Communications with Amport Parish Council, Amport Neighbourhood Plan Groups and Professional Advisor

21 June 2024 – Initial email to Sharon de Brú of Bluestone Planning requesting a meeting with her and the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group. No reply

24 June 2024 – Follow-up to NPSG copied to Sharon de Brú again requesting a meeting. No reply

27 June 2024 – I emailed Councillor Stephenson, copied to Sharon and NPSG again, requesting a meeting. I received an immediate reply saying she would get back to me soon.

17 July 2024 – Nothing was received from Councillor Stephenson, so I emailed to ask when she could come back to me. No reply

27 July 2024 - I emailed again. Councillor Stephenson replied that you are in the final stages of the NP. **No development decision has been made**, so a meeting would not be helpful.

27 July 2024 – I replied that they were, in fact, at the very early Stage 2 of the NP, so you should receive, record and consider all representations made to the NP by stakeholders. No Reply

1 August 2024: I emailed Councillor Stephenson to ask for a reply. She called me and asked me to email a detailed submission.

21 August 2024 – I emailed Councillor Stephenson with a draft Master Plan and again asked for a meeting with the NPSG. She requested a narrative, which I sent along with additional information on highways and sustainability. See the attached.

30 August 2024 – I emailed Councillor Stephenson to ask if the Master Plan and supporting documents had been circulated to the NP groups. She replied that the NPSG would not receive the submission until the NP was made. So, I asked that our submission be accepted and recorded, which she did not confirm.

30 August 2024—I emailed the submission to this Parish Council and District Councilors, again asking for it to be accepted and recorded and requesting a meeting. The PC Clerk replied, saying they were only considering developments of 10 homes or less, contrary to what I was told on **27 July**.

2 September 2024 – I emailed the Clerk to ask why, when your Housing Needs Survey showed a need for 11 – 20 home developments, you were only considering developments of 10 homes or less. No reply

16 September 2024 – Attend the Amport Parish Council Meeting, speak and submit the NP representations during Public Participation, voicing my concerns.

Between 30 August and 12 October, Councillor Stephenson and I exchanged emails, me asking if our representatives had formally been accepted and were being considered. She confirmed this but would not agree to us meeting the NPSG.
