**Applications for Designation of a Neighbourhood Area**  
**Andover (Town), Ashley, Charlton, Romsey (Town) and Romsey Extra**

The Council has received applications for designation of a Neighbourhood Area from the parish council for the Parishes of:

- Andover (Town)
- Ashley
- Charlton
- Romsey (Town) and Romsey Extra – joint application

For each application, the proposed area to be covered is the whole parish. Designation by the Council as a Neighbourhood Area would enable a Neighbourhood Plan to be prepared for each designated parish area.
