

### Corporate Action Plan Review

This presentation brings together the four years of the Corporate Action Plan which sat under the 2015-19 Corporate Plan: Investing in Test Valley.





## Live where the supply of homes reflects local needs

- A total of 733 new affordable homes have been delivered since 2016, exceeding the initial target of 600, with 250 being provided in 2018/19
- Implementation of the Homelessness Reduction Act
- An additional £100k invested in front line housing options service. Reduced the number of households being accepted under the main statutory homelessness duty by 83% through a proactive approach to preventing homelessness.
- The number of households in temporary accommodation has also reduced by 24%.

### Work and do business

- Town Centre enhancements delivered in Andover including wayfinding, arches and heritage trail
- Enhancements to Bell Street, Church Street and the Market Place in Romsey completed in partnership with HCC
- Skills Fund investment in Andover to date has supported 509 employees and 142 businesses
- A new £3.9M Skills and Technology Centre in Andover opened in 2016
- Walworth and Portway business parks are now able to access high speed broadband
- 10 Independent Retailer grants were given out 2018/19
- 32 Business Incentive Grants were given out 2018/19





# Enjoy the natural and built environment


- We have adopted and taken on the management of Fishlake Meadows
- The Waste Strategy was reviewed and a new one implemented with an Action Plan put in place
- A new 30 year leisure contract has been let with Places for People, which will result in £18M worth of investment into borough facilities. The new £16M Andover Leisure Centre opened on 1 April 2019.
- Updates to Romsey Memorial Park including outdoor gym equipment and the war horse memorial





# Contribute to and be part of a strong community

- £1M was awarded to 69 projects via the Community Asset Fund 2015-19
- £327K awarded to 409 community projects via the Councillor Community Grant Scheme for 2015-19
- Andover Vision launched its renewed Vision with a new action plan
- Romsey Future moves from strength to strength in taking forward its action plan, beginning the South of town centre project and launching a tourism work stream.
- Our approach to community empowerment has continued to be developed through the development and hosting of one of three national conferences with the Councillor Commission.
- The Local Government Boundary Commission for England consulted on and implemented new wards in Test Valley, a full Community Governance Review of Test Valley's parish boundaries following and being adopted







### Wider Council Achievements

- MJ Awards Finalist in the Local Authority of the Year Awards 2017
- A successful LGA Peer Challenge in October 2018 in which TVBC was recognised as a wellled and effectively managed authority with a strong track-record of good investments and delivery.
- At the leading edge of practice around work with councillors, including leading an innovation zone session at the 2018 LGA conference and hosting two "Be a Councillor" events with the LGA







- Housing grant success, accessing over £200k, housing team shortlisted for national heroes award
- The re-location of the job centre, making accessing services simpler for our customers
- The acquisition of the Magistrates Court in Andover and properties including the Chantry Centre
